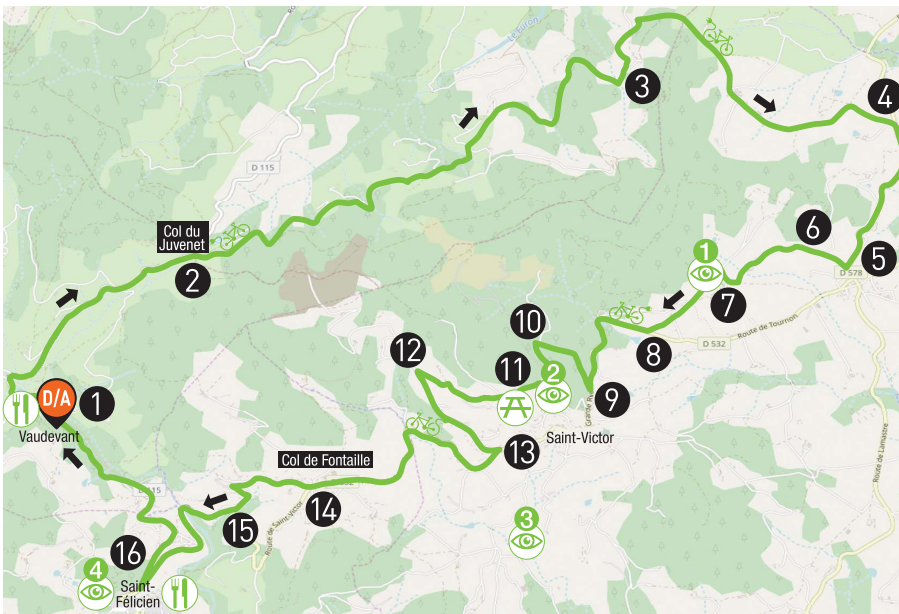
## THE PLATEAU MIDWAY [VAUDEVANT]

### In the countryside

Ideal for getting to know your e-bike. With uphill slopes not too steep and downhill ones giving you time to rest, little traffic and to top it all fantastic landscapes.

### ROADBOOK

- 1 **0 km** Follow the main road towards Satillieu and go uphill towards col du Juvenet.
- 2 **2,7 km** Turn right at the pass onto a small road signed up Les Hubacs.
- 3 **8,5 km** Turn second right after Monichet then continue straight on.
- 4 **11,4 km** Turn right at the giveway sign on the main road.
- 5 **13 km** Turn right just before the stop sign towards Navas.
- 6 **13,8 km** Go past the hamlets L'Hôte and Pral then continue straight on.
- 7 **13,9 km** Straight on at the crossroads with the 11th-century chapel then turn left immediately.
- 8 **15,1 km** Turn right at the giveway sign as you come to the main road.
- 9 **16,2 km** Turn right onto the small road signed up "Table d'orientation, Le Cardère, Dragonnet."
- 10 **16,9 km** Turn left then continue uphill to the "table d'orientation, Le Cardère, Genest".
- 11 **18 km** Carry straight on past the hamlet Les Bauds.
- 12 **18,7 km** At the crossroads signed up "Les Bauds" where you have just come from, turn left and go down to the main road.
- 13 **19,9 km** At the stop sign, follow the main road on the right.
- 14 **22 km** Go past "col de Fontaille" and just after, turn onto the small road signed up Jury.
- 15 **23,2 km** Once on the main road again at the bottom continue on the right side.
- 16 **24,7 km** As you enter Saint-Félicien, turn right towards Vaudevant and return to the village.

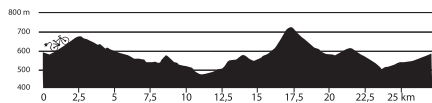

**1 NOTRE DAME DE NAVAS** : Charming country chapel in the village with 3 steeples. The peculiarity of this chapel is the black Madonna.

**2 SAINT-VICTOR VIEWING TABLE** : It's worth the effort, after a rather continuous climb uphill, when you discover the viewpoint : the "3 Becs" in the southern Vercors mountains and even the Mount Ventoux can be seen on a fine day.

**3 REAT FARM** : "Tomme en salade" a genuine local dish ! Tomme cheese seasoned with various herbs is usually served on a jacket potato. The ones made in Réat Farm are delicious !

**4 THE CHURCH IN ST FELICIEN** : A brief visit inside is interesting for its architecture.



**PICNIC CORNER** : On a fine day the viewing table in Saint-Victor almost allows you to touch the southern peaks. An ideal spot for charging your batteries and daydreaming.
