Transportation to the rendez-vous spot : by train (free with the cartes d'hôtes) or by car-pool.

Whenever possible, we will make a stop in a pleasant café, refuge or tea room for a warm drink. (Beverages not included.) In the event of very poor weather: A back-up date will be proposed during the week.

CHAMONIX - SUN TO SUNSET & SWEET CONFECTIONS OF A MASTER CHEF

We walk up an ancient path to a little-known neighborhood where still no cars can climb. Changing light on the Mont Blanc will be the setting. We'll then enjoy a well-earned warm drink & dessert creation in one of Chamonix's best gastronomic destinations. It will be twilight hour as the holiday lights begin to sparkle. Plan on 15€ for tea & cakes.



CHAMONIX - OFF THE BEATEN TRACK IN TOWN + HIGH TEA IN A PALACE-HOTEL

Rustic habitats mingle with alpine aristocracy. A labyrinth of paths take us to a secluded part of town where restored farmhouses and turn-of-the century villas face the Mont Blanc. The grand tradition of high tea awaits us back in town in a charming palace-hotel. Plan on 15€ for the high tea.



SERVOZ - WHERE RURAL CHARM MINGLES WITH LOCAL TRADITION, ARCHITECTURE AND CUISINE

A traditional rural village where artists, chefs and farmers strive to maintain a quality of life and express their talent. Servoz is famous for its baroque church, rural architecture, red cows and good food. My advice: have lunch in one of the good country inns in town before the walk.



VALLORCINE - WELL-GROOMED SNOW PATHS THROUGH A UNIQUE MOUNTAIN VILLAGE

At the north end of the valley lies one of the most curious mountain villages in the Alpes. We'll visit the heart of the ancient Walser hamlets and the great avalanche wall before rubbing elbows with the locals in Guy Ancey's village café. The winter solstice light, cold and blue, will delight the photographers.



TRÉLECHAMPS - A PRESERVED ENVIRONNEMENT IN A STORY-BOOK SETTING

Simply a magical experience on this protected plateau of forest, snow fields and traditional chalets. Wonderful photographs to be taken in all weather conditions. Very special if it snows. And perfect for families. The experience will be even more enjoyable if you arrive to Montroc using the little red train.



CHAMONIX - SUNSET AND BLUE LIGHT MAGIC IN THE LATE AFTERNOON.

A late-afternoon walk in the high-perched neighborhoods facing the Mont Blanc timed to coincide with the unique blue light, a favourite for twilight photographers. A tripod can come in handy on this walk although not mandatory. We'll stop by my favourite place for a well deserved hot-chocolat or mulled wine in front of the fireplace on our way back. Beverages not included.



CHAMONIX - DISCOVER A TYPICAL CHAMONIARD NEIGHBORHOOD AND HISTORIC FAMILY HOTEL

Regardless of the winter cold, it's always a heart-warming experience to come to Les Mouilles. Generations of Chamonix families and artisans still work and live in this hamlet, tucked discreeting away from the hustle & bustle of downtown. We'll stop for a warm drink in the cosy salon of one of Chamonix's oldest family establishments. Beverages not included.



CHAMONIX - WE VISIT THE KITCHEN OF CHEF BOURDILLAT BEFORE DISCOVERING CHAMONIX

The famous chef Mickey Bourdillat continues to welcome us into his fascinating kitchen where he conducts his team of chefs and pastry-makers while they prepre lunch. We'll have carte blanche to photograph, ask questions, recipes, exchange notes with the staff. Plan on lunch at the end of the walk for an unbeatable price - 25 € beverages not included.
