Notre-Dame de Senanque Abbey is a Cistercian monastery since 1148. The community of the monks gives you the opportunity to visit the 12th century buildings: the church, the cloister, the chapter-hall, the warming room and the dormitory. Turn back time visiting the abbey with the Histopad, a digital tablet which transports you in the everyday life of the first monks and then, gives you the opportunity to meet the current community. Histopad available in 10 languages: French, English, German, Spanish, Italian, Dutch, Japanese, Chinese, Polish and Portuguese).

Concessions for disabled persons and unemployed (on presentation of the card)

Free for child under 6, for priests and members of a religious order and for professional guides (on presentation of the card)

Visits reserved to individuals. Groups are received only on reservation: specific hours and conditions. **Proper dress code and silence are required.**

Seeing as there are many stairs in the medieval abbey, the access for disabled persons is particularly difficult and impossible with a wheelchair.

Dogs and other pets are not allowed inside the abbey (except assistance dogs).
