

CAPSULA



CAPSULA est un couple Rock 'n' Roll composé de Martin Guevara, le frontman guitariste chanteur et Coni à la basse. Accompagné de Alvaro à la batterie, Capsula est une énorme vague de sons pourris et sauvages des années 70, du glam au garage (pensez Bowie et T-Rex) avec un souffle de psychédéisme d'Amérique du Sud, leurs racines.

Leurs énergies brutes et live vont vous cueillir à coup sûr. Ils sont passés maîtres du mélange des sons des différentes décennies, Post-punk, Garage, psyché, en passant par la pop et les riffs biens lourds.

Nés en Argentine, ils déménagent en Europe pour faire le tour du monde, prennent pour patronyme une des chansons de David Bowie "Space Oddity", sans savoir que des années plus tard, ils allaient travailler avec le cerveau créatif de T-Rex derrière la console, le célèbre producteur de Bowie, Tony Visconti.

"Lorsque toutes les croyances humaines échouent, nous avons toujours le rock and roll, avec la promesse de nous remonter le moral les jours sombres et de nous enivrer jusqu'à ce que nous perdions connaissance. Tout recommence en écoutant simplement un disque vinyle ou en criant «un, deux, trois» dans un microphone.

Fureur et luxure, électricité et esprit, dynamisme et sensualité. Rock and roll...

Rares sont les groupes qui comprennent, disons par intuition, cette réalité comme le fait Capsula. Et on dirait qu'aucun d'eux ne le vit, ne l'assimile, ne le pratique et ne le construit comme eux, surtout dans leurs performances live volcaniques.

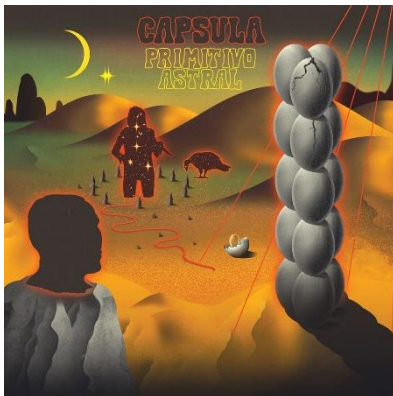

2024 - PRIMITIVO ASTRAL

The dynamic garage-rock and heavy psych-rock trio, Capsula, returns with their electrifying new 10-track album, *Primitivo Astral*, set to shake up the underground music scene once again.
