


DOUX VALLEY [LAMASTRE]

Bike + Train

Get on board the Mastrou, a genuine steam train, and follow the Doux Valley uphill to Lamastre then, all the way back, downhill to Tournon-sur-Rhône.

ROADBOOK

- 1 0 km Follow the directions to Saint-Félicien and stop at Arlebosc
- 2 12,4 km On leaving the village fork right signed up Boucieu-le-Roi.
- 3 15,9 km Just before crossing the bridge of the river Doux, go straight on along the bottom valley road.
- 4 21,5 km At the railway station turn left up towards the main road without crossing the river.
- 5 21,9 km Follow the main road on the right side for a few kilometres.
- 6 24,5 km Turn right onto the D534 towards Saint-Barthélémy-le-Plain.
- 7 26,4 km As you enter Saint Barthélémyle-Plain, turn left onto the D238 towards Tournon-sur-Rhône.
- 8 31,7 km Cross the bridge back to the railway station.

1 TRAIN DE L'ARDÈCHE (STEAM TRAIN) : The train whistle echoing in the valley bottom, the smell of coal, the sound of the locomotive wheels on the tracks are all sensations taking you back in time (on booking only).

2 THE DOUX GORGES: Discover the untouched and rather secret landscape of this valley from all sides by bike or train.
