QUESTION 5: DRAW THE WASHHOUSE OF LE POUZIN.

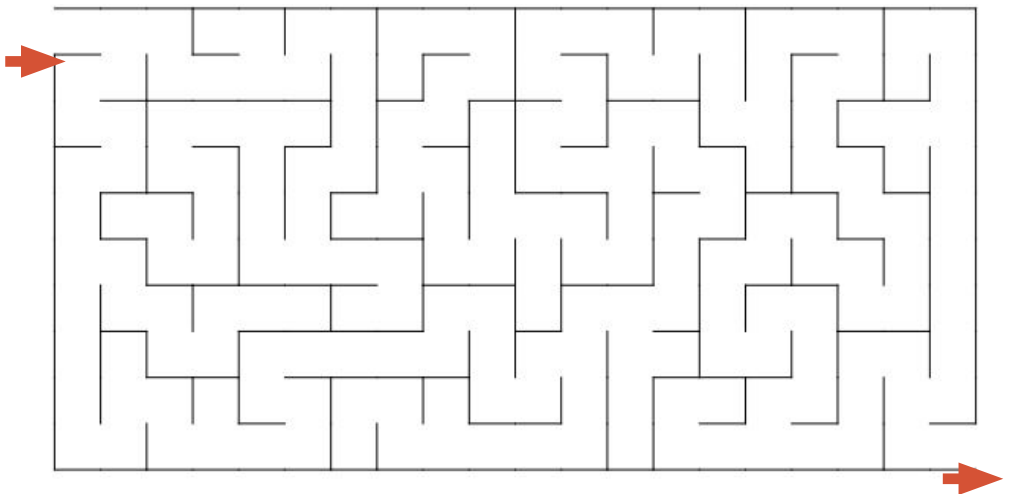


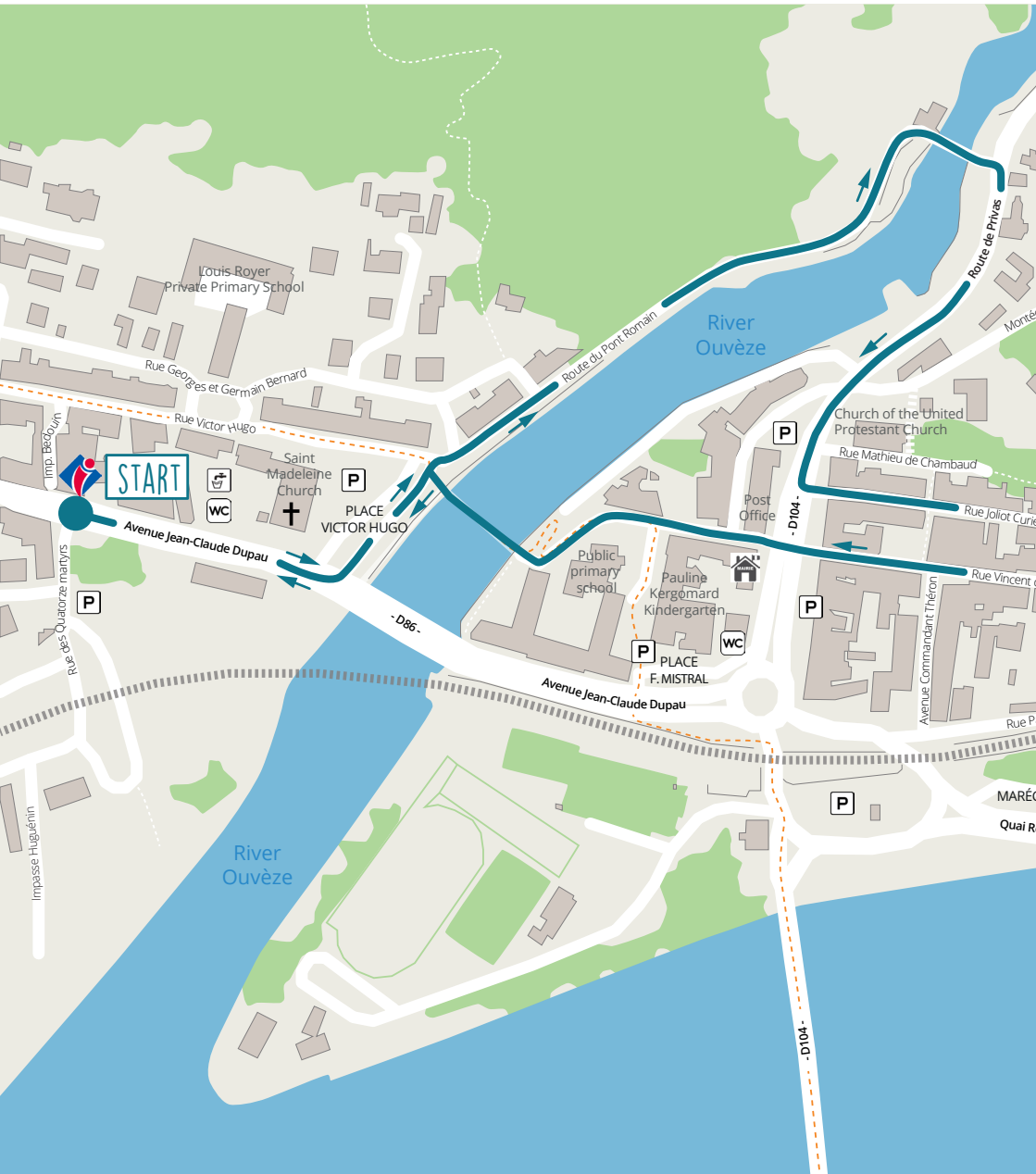

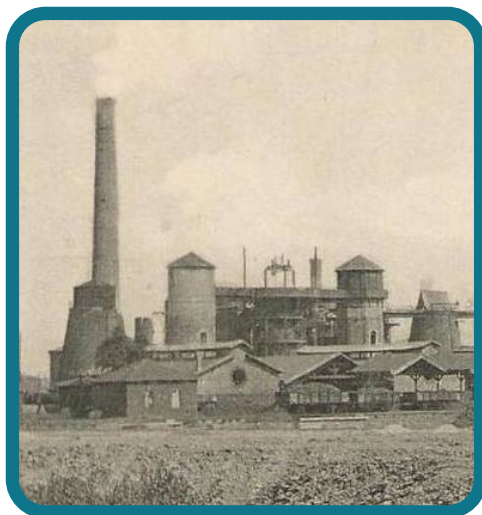

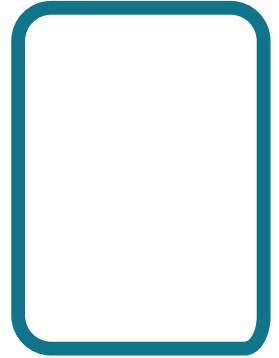
