

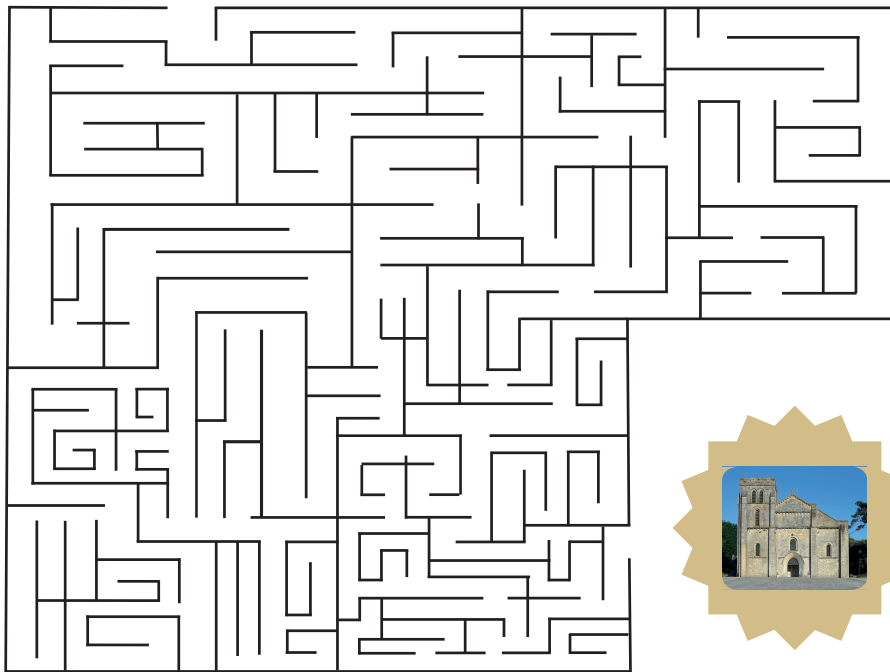

Start

Let's begin ! The course starts at the Tourism Office.
