

Pointe de Tréchauffé

This hike begins with a climb to the Col de l'Aiguille, with the goats keeping you company at. The path then climbs through the forest until you reach the Pointe de Tréchauffé and its magnificent panorama of Lake Geneva. From the summit you can also enjoy views of the peaks of the Vallée d'Aulps and the Swiss Jura.

Description

(D) Start from the Tréchauffé car park (located after the lookout point and the chalets de Tréchauffé). From the car park, retrace your steps for 300 metres along the road towards the Tréchauffé chalets.

(1) Take the path on the right towards the [Pointe de Tréchauffé](#).

(2) At the Col de l'Aiguille, take the path on the right that leads into the forest until you reach a very steep section equipped with metal staircases designed to make the climb easier.

(3) At the summit, leave the path and go right to reach the Pointe de Tréchauffé about 50 metres away.

(A) Return along the same path.
