USE OF CABLE CARS

The chosen solution is the use of 3 cable cars from Allemond to Alpe d'Huez over a period from Friday, July 24, 2026 at 06:30 to Saturday, July 25, 2026 at 06:30, because the D1091 providing access to the town of Allemond will be closed from 06:30.

These ski lifts will also ensure the return of people benefiting from an outbound journey, after the event on Saturday, July 25, 2026, from 1:00 p.m.

Access to these gondolas will be reserved for socio-professionals working in the Alpe d'Huez resort.

The proposed solution includes access to the Allemond cable car parking lot (200 spaces) for socio-professionals.
