- 2 Saint Julien Collegiate Church (early 14th century)
- 3 Castle-Museum of Tournon (16th century)
- 4 Former private mansion of the salt tax holder (17th century)
- 4 Granary for salt (15th century)
- 5 Under-prefecture of Tournon (1853)
- 6 Stéphane Mallarmé in Tournon (1860 to 1863)

- 7 Mauves Gate (16th century)
- 8 Watchtower (16th century) - Virgin statue added in 1866
- 9 Private mansion of Courbis (16th century) - Palué Museum
- 10 Place du Taurobole, 10 Autel du Taurobole (OT)
- 11 Church of Notre Dame de Tain (19th century)
