Topic: Rules of procedure of the camper van area – Quai Jacques Prévert Prolongé in Meaux

The mayor of Meaux,

In view of the general local authority code, most notably articles L. 2212-1, L. 2212-2, L 2333-30, L. 3333-1, L. 2531-17, and L. 2531-18,

In view of traffic regulations, notably articles L. 411-1, R. 411-8, R. 411-21-1, R. 411-25, R. 417-10, and R.417-12,

In view of decision N° CC23060227 of June 16 2023 of the municipality community council of the Meaux region,

In view of the repeal of decree n° 19-597 from 25/03/2019,

Considering that a camper van area has been built at Quai Jacques Prévert prolongé in Meaux,

Considering that the camper van area is at the disposal of camper van users from April 1st to October 31st,

Considering that it is necessary to regulate the camper van area of Meaux,

Considering that it is up to the Mayor to take all useful measures to prevent accidents, to keep things in order, to ensure safety, security, and public hygiene,

Considering that camper van users are invited to read carefully the following rules of procedure and strictly comply with them during their stay at the camper van area of Meaux,

DECREE

ARTICLE 1 - PARKING

Parking on the camper van area of Quai Jacques Prévert prolongé in Meaux is strictly reserved to camper vans. It is forbidden for any other type of vehicle. Parking of a camper van must be done in the specific demarcated locations.

Parking is limited to 2 days.

ARTICLE 2 - ACCESS

The camper van area can be freely accessed from avenue du Maréchal Foch in Meaux.

ARTICLE 3 - RATES

The camper van area has 5 parking places.

Parking is charged, as is access to fluids. Users are to pay via the payment terminal with a credit card.

If the payment terminal is not working, call Meaux Marne Ourcq Tourisme (open from Tuesday to Sunday from 10h to 12h30 and from 14h to 18h. Closed on Monday. Closed on May 1st). Each camper van must display the parking ticket from the terminal behind its windshield so it is visible from the outside in case of a control.

Rates decided by the Mayor by decree n° 2023-730 of August 3rd 2023 are the following:

ARTICLE 4 – SERVICES

<u>Drinking water:</u> A water fountain is available on site. Its use is charged and is done by pressure on the tap head. The water fountain is strictly reserved to water tanks refill.

<u>Draining:</u> Draining of chemical tapes are to be done in the receptacle near the water fountain, sewage disposal can be done in the ground cap connected to the sewer system: a water projection by sprinkler is done automatically during a camper van's parking on the allocated space.

Users, for hygiene reasons, have to respect these dispositions and maintain the cleanliness of the premises.

<u>Garbage</u>: Garbage have to be disposed of in the containers on site.

ARTICLE 5 – GENERAL STATE OF VEHICLES

Only camper vans in a normal state of circulation are authorized to stay on the camper van area.

ARTICLE 6

Any fixed installation or construction is prohibited on the camper van area as well as shared areas or any other place.

ARTICLE 7

Camper van area users are in no case authorized to leave anything on the area after their departure.

ARTICLE 8

Traffic and parking within the camper van area take place at the drivers', who retain custody and responsibility of the space, own risk, as would be the case for traffic or parking on the public road. Parking (and the resulting traffic) forms a simple authorization to use and occupy the camper van area.

This authorization cannot result in any case in a security deposit contract or of monitoring.

Therefore, the utilities of the camper van area are at the disposal of users who use them under their entire responsibility. It is the same for any material, object or personal effects of the users.

The city of Meaux reserves the right to close temporarily the camper van area for reasons of safety of users, vehicles or equipments.

ARTICLE 9

Every user of the camper van area is responsible degradation he causes or that would be caused by a person under its responsibility, or any animal or item under its responsibility. It will consequently be liable to pay full compensation for the corresponding damage. As a consequence, every user must individually respect the installations and is legally responsible for any damage caused. Children are under the full responsibility of parents who must survey them.

ARTICLE 10

Users must respect each other and observe a perfect correction towards their neighbors and staff intervening on the camper van area. Sound of diverse apparels (TV, Radio, etc.) should be of a reasonable power. They must in no way disturb public order. The us of power generators is strictly prohibited.

ARTICLE 11

Users are required to comply strictly with health and hygiene regulations. Each user is responsible for the state of cleanliness of the space he is parking on. He must maintain it in a good state as well as its surroundings, for example, by not leaving papers, plastic bottles, glass shards and any type of packaging on the camper van area. Sewage evacuation can only be done on the allocated spaces on the camper van area.

ARTICLE 12

Containers are at the disposal of users. Any garbage dump is prohibited.

Furthermore, any disposal of waste other than garbage is prohibited in the containers (scrap metal, rubble, tyres, etc.)

ARTICLE 13

Any scrap metal disposal, the burning (tyres, wires, copper, plastics...) are not authorized on site. Open wood or coal fires or barbecues are prohibited.

Electric grills are allowed.

ARTICLE 14

Pets must be attached and their droppings collected by their owner. Owners must ensure they respect everyone's tranquility as well as green areas. Each animal must be kept by its owner, in compliance with current regulations (vaccination, etc.).

ARTICLE 15

Users must comply with traffic regulations and current signage.

In accordance with the Highway Code, speed is limited to 10km/h within the camper van area.

ARTICLE 16

Any infringement of the provisions of the present by-law will be recorded and prosecuted in accordance with the current laws and regulations.

ARTICLE 17
