



HIKE 2

SAINT-CLÉMENT



Nice walk for the whole family in the cool of the chestnut and cork oak trees, across the countryside, the vineyards and the fruit trees of St. Clement, accessible to everybody and possible even with windy weather.



The Chapel of St. Clement restored in the sixties by the sculptor Di Teana, olive groves, vineyards and chestnut groves.

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ITINERARY

From the tourist information go towards the exit of the village dir. Grimaud, after the Chapel St Eloi follow the small road to the left direction St Clément (behind the service station). The walk is indicated by No. 2. At 400 m you will see on the left the stele of St Clément.

Continue going down the road for about 1 km to the Chapel of St Clément.

Follow the road to the left (towards les Seignerolles). Later on this small road overlooks the plain of St Clément. Continue straight across chestnut groves,

the road leads to les Seignerolles, near the road (D75) to Plan de La Tour.

You can continue your walk and join the walk No. 4 going up the chemin du Curnier on the other side of the road. Otherwise turn left and follow the signs for No. 4, follow the path overlooking the road. Cross the D75 and take the small road going down opposite (chemin du Défend).

You will arrive at the RD 558 again, go left in front of the cemetery, from there go up the rue Saint Jean to arrive at the tourist information again.
