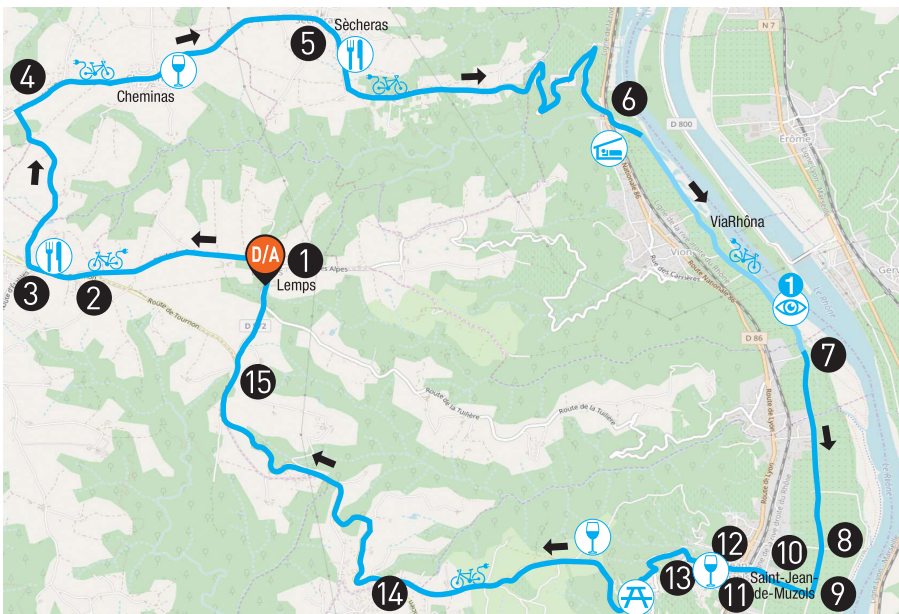
HANGING VINEYARDS [LEMPs]

Saint-Joseph route

Two different worlds with the plateau and its pastures and woodland then the hillside with its typical narrow, overhanging roads. On either side vineyards form terraces one of the area's features. The view overlooking the river Rhône as it meanders is simply splendid.

ROADBOOK

- 1 **0 km** Follow "route de Crémolière" opposite the townhall.
- 2 **1,7 km** Turn right at the giveaway sign.
- 3 **2,2 km** Turn right onto "route de Collet" then immediately left.
- 4 **3,9 km** Turn right onto the main road to Cheminas then Sècheras.
- 5 **6,8 km** Turn right signed up Arras-sur-Rhône.
- 6 **11,9 km** Turn right towards Vion then first left to pick up the ViaRhôna.
- 7 **14,7 km** Leave the cycling track and continue on the road straight on.
- 8 **16,9 km** Straight on at the stop sign.
- 9 **17,3 km** Turn right onto "chemin des Nautes".
- 10 **17,9 km** Turn left onto "route du château".*
- 11 **18 km** Cross the D86.*
- 12 **18,2 km** Take the 3rd exit at the roundabout heading towards the townhall and straight on on that road (steep uphill slope).*
- 13 **19,1 km** Continue uphill on "Côte Sainte-Epine".*
- 14 **22,2 km** Turn right at the stop sign.
- 15 **25,7 km** Turn right to Lempes.

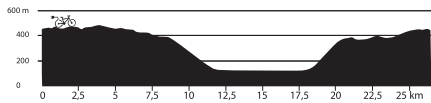

1 VIARHÔNA : The ViaRhôna links Lake Lemman to the Mediterranean sea (815km). It goes past Lyon then follows the river Rhône at the foot of St Joseph and Hermitage vineyards, zigzagging from bank to bank. It offers a safe and relaxing ride.



PICNIC CORNER : You can sit on a "chalais", a vineyard terrace, in the heart of the St Joseph appellation, for hours just looking at Hermitage vineyards and enjoying the scenery.

A LITTLE *bonus*

The St-JOSEPH AOC is an appellation with a very strong character coming from the granite stone soil that gives it a fine and powerful taste. In the past called vin de Mauves, it was served at Charlemagne's table.
