


CIRCUIT AROUND SAINT-PAUL DE VENCE VIA VALLON DU MALVAN





PLACE OF INTEREST

KM 0,0 place du Général de Gaulle **ALTITUDE** 177 m 06570 Saint-Paul de Vence



PLACE DE GAULLE

Historical Site

Also known as the "boules pitch", the square is the beating heart of Saint-Paul de Vence. Home to the famous Colombe d'Or inn and the Café de la Place, the site became a classic thanks to Yves Montand, Lino Ventura and their boules pitch skirmishes.

For hikers of all levels. The walk loops around the village of Saint-Paul de Vence from the foot of the western ramparts to the small valley of the River Malvan.

<u>Starting point</u>: Place de Gaulle. Follow the path which starts at the foot of the Bastion du Dauphin, to your right when facing the ramparts.



REMPARTS BASTIONNÉS

Monuments & Architecture

The ramparts and bastions of Saint-Paul de Vence were built by military engineer Jean de Renaud de Saint-Rémy by order of Francis I. Erected during the 1540s, they were decreed a Historical Monument in 1945.

Take the road running along the cemetery to the left, walk 150 m down to the gate and go through it. After 200 m, take the path down to the left leading to the River Malvan.

PORTARON TOWER

Monuments & Architecture

The horseshoe shaped tower dates back to the 1530s. It is thought to be the work of Italian Captain Rozato Melino Romain, commissioned by the consuls of Saint-Paul de Vence to reinforce the town's defences.



ITINERARY INFO N°2

KM 1,060 2256 ch. du Malvan ALTITUDE 70 m 06570 Saint-Paul de Vence

Turn left and follow Chemin du Malvan for 950 m. Turn left onto Impasse des Restanques. Walk alongside private gardens studded with olive and orange trees.

VALLON DU MALVAN

Historical Site

The source of the Malvan River stands above Vence. During the 14th century, Queen Jeanne of Provence authorised the community of Saint-Paul de Vence to use the water from the Malvan to run oil and flour mills. For a long time, this small valley was mainly dedicated to growing flowers and olives. Chemin du Malvan was paved over as late as the 1950s.



INFO PARCOURS N°3

KM 2,430 666 Sous Barri

ALTITUDE 130 m 06570 Saint-Paul de Vence

Follow the path and occasional steps (yellow trail indicators) for 250 m. To the right, follow the concrete path to the asphalt road and back up to the ramparts. Follow the fortifications towards the right, back to Place de Gaulle.
