This beautiful walk leads near an apiary of the 17<sup>th</sup> Century recently restored and joins the path of Neuf Riaux where vestiges of an ancient water-mill can be found.

## ITINERARY

From the parking St Joseph follow the signs and go down the marked path for about 30 min. It leads to the barrage. Take the path to the left and ford the stream.

- Go up the hill opposite towards the apiary, don't go into the enclosed plot (attention of the bees!).
- Continue the marked path as far as the vestiges of the water-mill.
- Return by the same way.
