

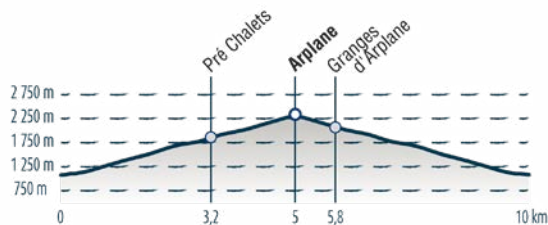


Access to start point

1, Rue de l'Église. Parking nearby.



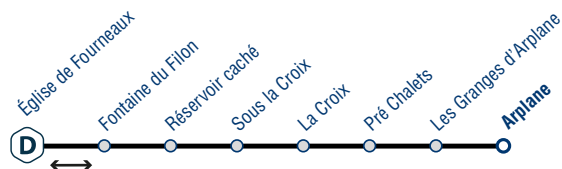

Hungry for cool forests and vast, wide-open spaces that hold the promise of adventure for seasoned hikers? Eager to take to the heights amidst traditional barns, lush alpine meadows, and breathtaking views of the valley floor? On your marks, get set, go!



Along the way

If you relish a challenge and have an explorer's curiosity, this route is made for you. A whole plateau of surprises awaits you. Such a reward obviously demands some effort; there might be a treat for you along string of switchbacks gradually leading you from the Fourneaux forest to the first high-altitude meadow: wild strawberries.

Listen to branches rustling in the gentle breeze that rises from the valley... And what a surprise when Arplane and its charming old chalets reveal themselves! After this epic hike, enjoy a moment of tranquility amidst the fir trees. Take a break at the foot of the well-preserved ruins. Wander around exploring them at your leisure. Succulents and tall grasses intertwine under your feet as you relax, breathing in the fresh mountain air. At last, you've arrived at the gates of the famous Massif du Tabor nature reserve. The ultimate reward!

The little extra

If the peaks are calling out to you and you're not tired out from the day's exercise, you can go on hiking to 2,480 m of altitude.

Arriving at Le Truc is a special moment: the peaks feel so close! Pointe de l'Échelle, Grand Argentier, Pointe des Sarrasins, and Belle Plinier are now within reach.
