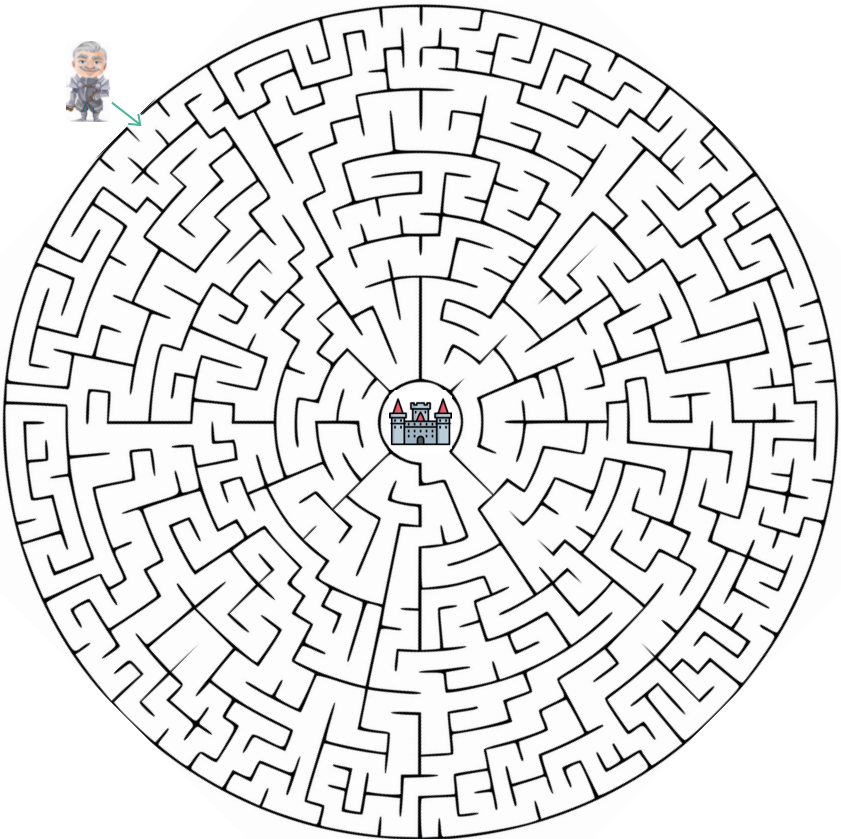

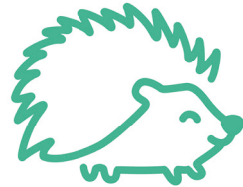

QUESTION 9: GO ALONG THE “CHEMIN DU MIRA”. WHAT DOES MIRA STAND FOR?

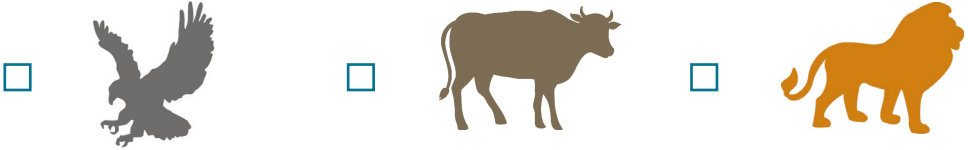
- Voir / observer *(See / observe)*

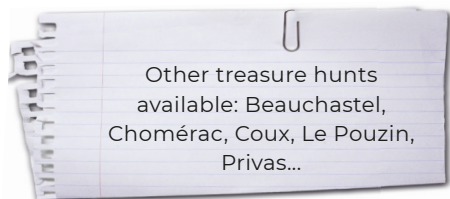
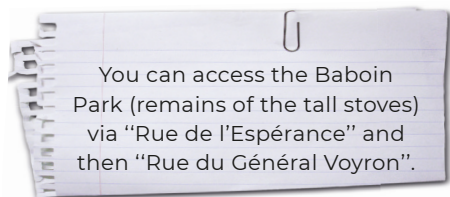
